On October 19, 2010 the Deputy Comptroller of Water Rights, Water Utility Act, took over management of the Anglemont and Acacia water system divisions of Anglemont Utilities Ltd. (the Utility) pursuant to Section 97 of the Utilities Commission Act.

Interior Utility Management Ltd. of Vernon BC is now overseeing the operations and maintenance of the Anglemont and Acacia water systems until further notice (manager Kevin Blaeser) and their contact phone number for emergencies or general system operations is 1-877-290-6764.

Overall management for these two divisions will be done by this office, for which there will be no charge to the customers.

A rate increase is necessary for the Utility to cover all forecast operating, maintenance and administration costs, including some urgently required extraordinary repairs and maintenance, and to set aside funds each year in the Replacement Reserve Trust Fund (RRTF) to ensure some funds are available to replace water system components when required.




Accordingly, the Deputy Comptroller has accepted for filing on an Interim basis effective November 1, 2010 an increase in domestic flat rates to \$60 per month or to \$54 per month net of a 10% discount available for all payments received within 21 days of the billings. Commercial rates will increase proportionately on a single family residential equivalent basis.

A billing for November and December 2010 is being issued through Harvey Lister & Webb. From all rates collected 20% will be deposited into the RRTF. Quarterly billings will continue in January 2011 when it is expected that another notice will be included providing opportunity to view the complete Rate Increase and Revenue Requirements information and submit any questions or comments to this office.

This increase does not include funds to upgrade the water system to meet the 4-3-2-1-0 water quality requirements of the Interior Health Authority under the Drinking Water Protection Act. The Columbia Shuswap Regional District (CSR D) has recently arranged for Engineering Studies to be completed on these water systems with a view for the CSR D to take them over pending successful completion of a water acquisition and customer assent process. Results of this study and progress on the water acquisition process will be communicated with you once determined.
